BACKGROUND

STUDY PURPOSE

- Quantify economic benefits generated by Workforce Solutions and its WIA-funded program
- Provide a set of demand-side performance metrics that go beyond common measures

STUDY TIMEFRAME

March to June 2011

BACKGROUND

- Seven pilot WIBs participating in EMSI study
 (2 WIBs in FL, 1 each in KY, MI, OR, MO, and WI)
- EMSI has extensive background in economic impact studies for community and technical colleges (1,100+ studies completed or ongoing)
- Research on economic contribution of WIBs will continue after first round of pilot studies is complete

- Workforce Solutions employed 73
 FTE staff
- Total payroll in PY 2009 was \$3.7
 million (including benefits)
- An additional \$5.5 million was spent in PY 2009 for supplies and services

BENEFITS OF ADULT/DISLOCATED WORKER PROGRAMS

- Workforce Solutions served 3,707
 adults and 2,231 dislocated
 workers in PY 2009
- Of these, 827 adults and 395 dislocated workers were placed into jobs



BENEFIT/COST ANALYSIS OF INVESTMENT EFFECTIVENESS

- Workforce Solutions' adult program received \$1.8 million in WIA funds in PY 2009
- Workforce Solutions' dislocated worker program received \$1.5 million in WIA funds

BENEFITS OF YOUTH PROGRAM

- Workforce Solutions served 899 youth participants in PY 2009
- Of these, 44 youth were placed into jobs
- An additional 118 youth had positive outcomes in education and training
